HOW TO USE SNAP BENEFITS AT THE FARMERS MARKET

1. VISIT THE MARKET INFO TENT

Tell a staff member or volunteer that you would like to use your EBT card



2. PURCHASE MARKET TOKENS

The staff will swipe your EBT card and give you tokens that act as cash at the market



3. SHOP THE MARKET!

Spend your tokens with any vendor selling SNAP eligible items.

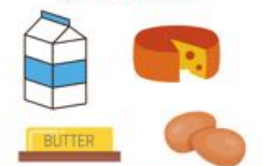

WHAT IS SNAP?

The Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP) offers nutrition assistance to millions of eligible, low-income individuals, including children, senior citizens, and families. Formerly known as the food stamp program, SNAP also provides economic benefits to communities.

SNAP helps households improve food security, reducing the number of people who skip meals because they don't have the money or resources to buy enough food.

HOW DO I APPLY?

SNAP benefits are determined by your annual income and the number of family members per household. To learn more about eligibility and how to apply for benefits, visit your local N.C. agency office or online at epass.nc.gov.
